Thank you for your interest in nominating a candidate. Since 1978, only 128 individuals have been selected to receive the industry's highest honor. The road to induction begins with the nomination packet. Here are a few tips to make the process go smoothly:

- The voting committee is interested in the quality of the nominee, not the quantity of information provided.
- Read over the procedures, criteria, and list of current inductees on the following pages before starting.
- Give yourself plenty of time to compile the required information and complete the packet.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

- A call for nominations will go out to individuals, key industry contacts, the management of a variety of groups, associations, sanctioning bodies, and event promoters who have a representative constituency in the off-road community. A call for nominations will also appear in selected print and electronic media.
- The nomination packet will be available online at www.ormhof.org. It will include the criteria for nomination, procedures outlining the schedule of actions, and list of current inductees. A nomination deadline of March 31, 2024 will be noted on the nomination form.

- If a nominee is not inducted, the nominator will be contacted and advised to update and resubmit the nomination packet for the second and third year. Nominees who are not inducted within three years will have a one-year waiting period before a nomination can be resubmitted.
- The nominator must be an ORMHOF member in good standing and submit the nomination on forms provided. [Join or renew here.](#)
- A nominator may nominate one or more persons. Each must be a separate submission.
- Voting committee members will receive nomination packets at least three weeks prior to the selection meeting.
- Nominee packets will be reviewed and a vote will be taken based on methods approved by the ORMHOF Board of Directors. A nominee must receive a vote from at least two thirds of the committee to be considered for induction. A maximum of seven nominees will be submitted to the Board of Directors for final approval.
- Upon approval by the Board of Directors, nominees shall be inducted into the Off-Road Motorsports Hall of Fame at the annual induction ceremony.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION AND INDUCTION

I. Nomination Criteria

A. An individual with at least 15 years of active involvement in the category to which they are being nominated.

B. Nominee has made a significant contribution to the off-road world, to including any of the following.

- Business development
- Design and engineering
- Philanthropy
- Exceptional performance with category
- Event promotion
- Inspiration to others
- Advocacy and activism
- Positive representation

II. Nomination Categories

- Influencer
- Competition – motorcycle
- Competition – UTV/ATV
- Competition – vehicle
- Advocacy
- Industry
- Journalism

III. Nomination and Voting Process

A. Nomination Process

1. Submitting nominations:

- Nominations are accepted on the approved online form only
- Nominations must be concise and not exceed the number of pages allotted
- Nominations not on the approved form will be returned to the nominator

2. Nominations are accepted from:

- Individuals
- Associations
- Groups
- Sanctioning bodies
- Event promoters
- Members of industry
- Members of the media

3. Acquiring nomination forms:

- Forms will be available February 1, 2024 on the ORMHOF website: www.ormhof.org

B. Voting Process

1. Voting committee duties:

- Meet annually to vote on nominees
- Members individually review nomination packets and vote on final selection
- Committee chair shall forward a list of proposed inductees to the ORMHOF Board of Directors for approval

2. Voting committee structure:

- Will include up to twenty (21) members consisting of:
 - A minimum of two (2) and a maximum of five (5) members of the ORMHOF Board of Directors
 - A minimum of Six (6) at-large members of the off-road community representing all categories. The voting committee chairman shall make this selection
 - A minimum of three (3) current ORMHOF inductees

C. Induction Process

- Voting committee will meet in person to review nominations
- Ballots are anonymous

- Ballots are pre-printed
- Ballots are retained
- Induction ceremony to be held annually
- Maximum induction class size of seven (7) unless otherwise approved by the ORMHOF Board of Directors
- Minimum induction class size of three (3)

IMPORTANT!

The quality rather than the quantity of the information provided will help voting committee members evaluate the nominee more fully. They are busy professionals; please be respectful of their time and follow the format. Packets that exceed the size limit will be returned. As you develop your information, pay close attention to sharing the nominee's narrative. Focus on their achievements, and equally as important, what they have given back to the off-road motorsports community.
